Marrel offers three steel hooks adapted to each container height. Durable hooks that are easy to remove if replacement is necessary.



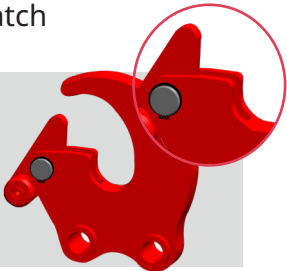
Without safety latch

HT 1425 - Welded hook



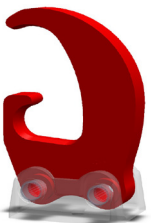
HT 1570 - Removable hook
